Phase 1: Learning

- 1. 30-Hours Fundamentals Training Course (Annually in Jan-March/April)
- 2. 10 Hours Observe an ACBC Certified Counselor
 - a. Watch the 10 counseling sessions
 - i. document using the ACBC Counselor Observation Log
 - b. 10 Counseling Sessions: \$79.00 rental

Phase 2: Exams & Application

- 1. Theology Exam: 24 Questions
 - a. Each question: 1-1.5 pages long
 - b. Format: 1" margins, 1.5" spacing, 12 point Times New Roman font
 - c. Footnotes: author, name of book, pages used
- 2. Counseling Exam: 20 Questions; includes 3 Sample Counseling Cases
- 3. **Online Application**: Grader will not grade your exams until all app items are completed, submitted
 - a. Application
 - b. Submission of Observation (10 hours) and Reading Logs (1000 pages)
 - c. Pastor/Elder Evaluation
 - d. Colleague Evaluation
 - e. Church Member and Authority Letter
 - f. Submission of Ordination Certificate (optional men only)
 - g. Submission of Theology and Counselor Exams
 - h. Create an ACBC Candidate Account, Pay Application Fee

SUPERVISED COUNSELING

Phase 3 is where the rubber meets the road in ACBC Certification. Over the course of a year, you will complete 50 sessions of supervised counseling with an ACBC Fellow.

1. Select a Fellow

a. Choose a Fellow from a list of available Fellows sent to you after you pass your exams.

2. Notify ACBC

a. Notify the ACBC office once the Fellow has agreed to be your supervisor.

3. 50 Sessions

- a. Complete 50 sessions (totaling a minimum of 50 hours) of supervised counseling.
 - i. Counseling supervision is often completed remotely via email and telephone.
 - ii. You will need to complete and send your supervisor a Case Report for each counseling session.
 - iii. At least 10 sessions must be with the same counselee.
 - iv. Audio record a minimum of 5 sessions to review and discuss with your supervising Fellow.
 - v. The 50 sessions must be completed within one year.

4. Case Report Review

a. Meet with your supervisor to review each Case Report.

5. Recommendation for Membership

a. After you have completed 50 sessions of counseling that your supervisor is satisfied with, he will submit a recommendation for membership.
